Volunteer from Nordic ski club designed this sign:

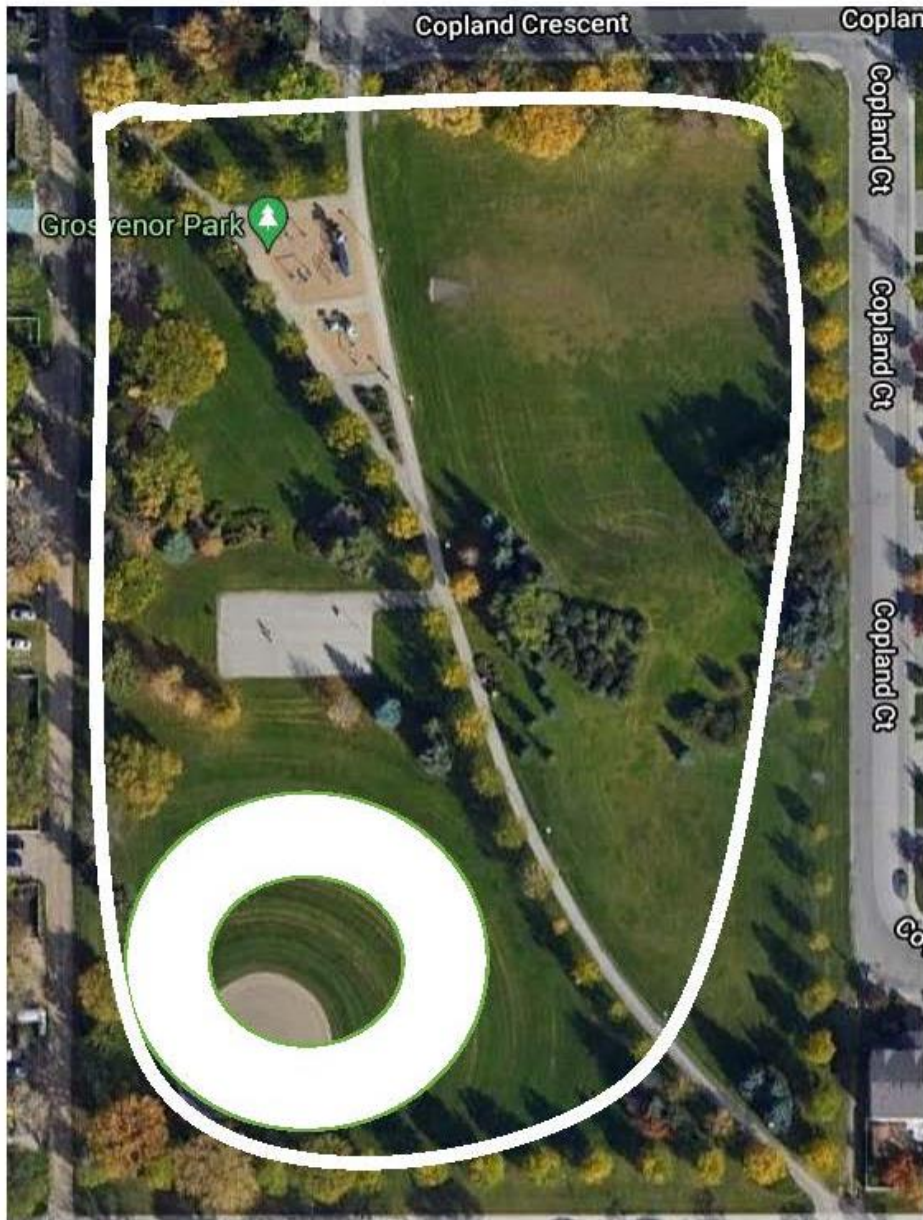
Please no walking or snowshoeing on the ski trails.



Ski Trail Etiquette

- If you enjoy walking in areas where there are ski trails, please respect skiers and avoid groomed trails. Footprints can damage the ski tracks and skating lanes, making skiing difficult and less enjoyable.
- Dogs are not permitted on ski trails.
- Please obey directions on one-way trails.
- Ski on the right on double tracks.
- Please step off the trail for faster skiers.
- Please do not ski on trails when temperature is above -1° C.
